



Global Greenhouse Gas Reporting Policy

In addition to Arrow's environmental sustainability guiding principles outlined in our [Global Environmental Sustainability Policy](#), Arrow displays our ongoing dedication to minimizing the industry's environmental footprint through the below approaches regarding the measurement and reduction of greenhouse gases.

Arrow collaboratively supports and encourages our customers and suppliers to measure and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. We also work to facilitate the transition to a low-carbon economy through the products and services we provide.

Emission Measurement and Reduction Actions

- i. **Annual greenhouse gas emissions reporting.** In accordance with the [Greenhouse Gas Protocol](#), Arrow will continue to take a data-driven approach to reporting through our [ESG report](#) and public CDP disclosure on:
 - a. Scope 1
 - b. Scope 2
 - c. Relevant categories of scope 3, including but not limited to the *Purchased Goods and Services* and *Use of Sold Products* categories
- ii. **Setting and reporting on climate targets.** Arrow will continue our emissions reductions efforts as evidenced by our goals to:
 - a. Reduce Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 10% across all Arrow locations and fleet by the end of 2025 as compared to 2022.
 - b. Set [science-based targets \(SBTs\)](#) in alignment with the [Science Based Target Initiative \(SBTi\)](#) by the end of 2025; following our 2023 [commitment](#) to SBTi.
 - c. Aspire to 100% renewable electricity by 2030.
- iii. **Managing a supplier engagement program.** In addition to providing education to our suppliers, Arrow will encourage our suppliers to:
 - a. Measure and report on their greenhouse gas emissions
 - b. Set science-based emissions reduction targets
 - c. Share emissions data and, where possible, product carbon footprint and/or lifecycle assessment data with Arrow to facilitate more mature reporting across the value chain.
- iv. **Auditing, verifying, and validating all greenhouse gas emissions measurements, goals, and reports.** Arrow will do so at least annually through:
 - a. Our internal corporate audit function
 - b. Starting no later than 2026, a third-party assurance provider
